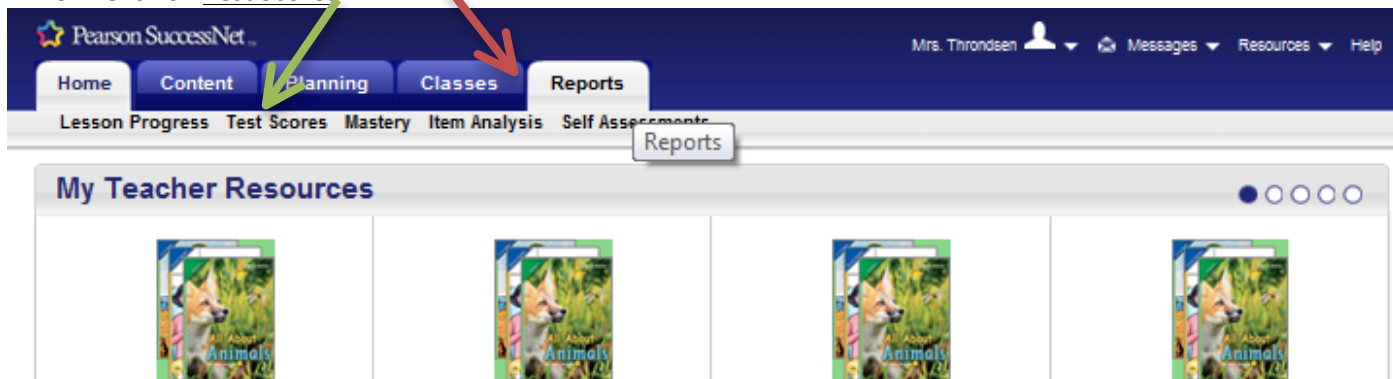


Pulling Class Reports—TEST SCORES

1. Login to Pearson SuccessNet
2. **Scroll** over the Reports Tab
3. **Click** on Test Scores



4. View each students score. The class average will be at the bottom for each test.

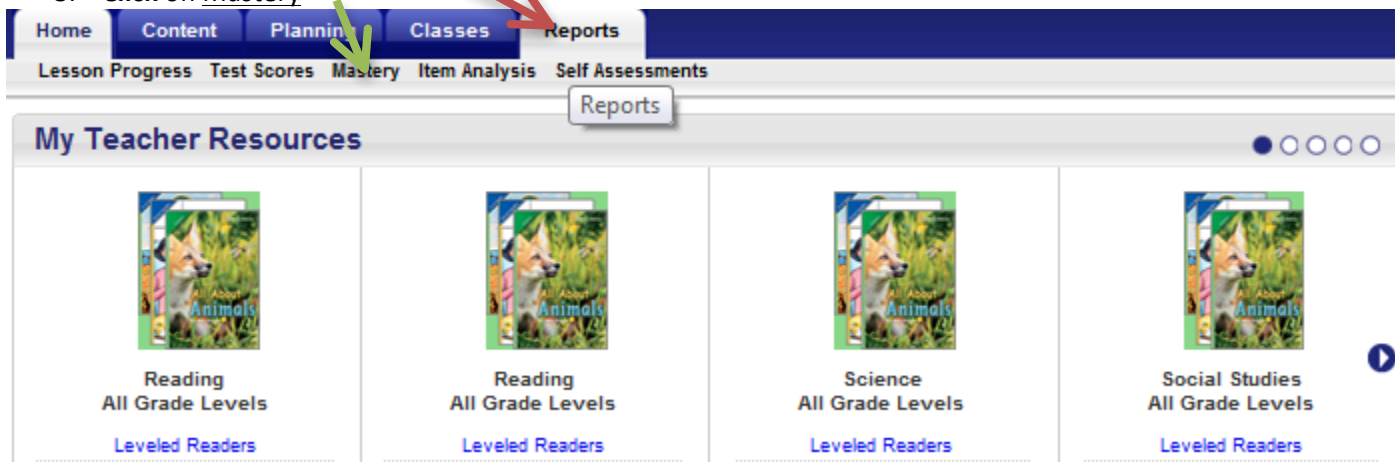
